This excursion heads to the central part of Malta, dominated by the ancient citadel of Medina, once the Island's capital city and steeped in history. In the year 60 AD a big storm hit the Maltese Islands this brought in and shipwrecked a galley with 47 persons aboard, in one of the beautiful bays of Malta. Among the crew, there was the Apostle Paul.

During the tour, the guide will first take you to Rabat, thus visiting St. Paul's Grotto where the Apostle Paul lived for three months. A walk through the narrow winding streets of Rabat would give a taste of the early medieval architecture.
